- Provides education for the pediatric in-and outpatients while they receive treatment in both hospitals
- Organizes education following the state school curriculum, by the means of educational developmental games and other alternative ways
- Serves as a basis for the child's reintegration into home school after treatment in the hospital













- Serves towards the child's emotional and psychological improvement
- Is the only place where inpatients and outpatients can communicate
- Provides a temporary escape and a positive distraction for children and their families

The Special Educators' Club


Is a practical professional exchange platform for the specialists working with the children with educational needs in general schools and support centers outside the hospital
